Construction begins at Esperance

Construction of the Gold Coast's most luxurious new waterfront retirement community is getting under way at Esperance Hope Island.

With one-third of the first stage already sold, Esperance will transform a disused site into a deluxe precinct and set a new regional benchmark for exclusive resident amenities.

The project will ultimately deliver around 300 deluxe apartments and villas with more than a hectare of green space alongside 150 metres of prime water frontage. Future plans include dedicated aged care living options and ground floor retail offerings.

Reside Communities CEO Glen Brown said he was thrilled with how strongly Esperance had resonated with local downsizers.

"Esperance is a groundbreaking project in every part of its design and with earthworks now under way, we are looking forward to our vision quickly becoming a reality," Glen said.

Esperance's first stage, Esprit, features a range of apartments from spacious two-bedroom, two-bathroom homes to stunning threebedroom penthouses with sweeping water and island views. Prices start from \$550,000.

A large central green plaza will create a vibrant community hub for Esperance, complete with water features, walking paths and lush lawns, while a new boardwalk will run the full length of the village's canal frontage.

Exclusive recreation amenities will include a cinema, bar, café, library, private function and dining rooms, and outdoor barbecue and entertaining spaces.

Health and wellbeing will be well catered for with an indoor therapy-focused swimming pool, indoor/outdoor resort-style pool, gym, yoga and Pilates studio, hair and beauty salon, health and wellness spaces, and outdoor exercise lawns for activities such as yoga and tai chi.

Located on Sickle Avenue at Hope Island, residents will be just across the road from all the shopping and dining options of Hope Island Marketplace, and within easy walking distance of numerous health and leisure services.
